


Resources


- List of 73 unionized public and academic libraries in New Jersey (as complete as we know). No school libraries. Academic libraries are undercounted.

 Academy
- National Labor Relations Board (Rights to form a union and to be represented in disciplinary matters)
- Civil Service Libraries (A library may be unionized, civil service, both, or neither.)





Survey of 300 academic and public library directors (April-May 2024)






Unionized vs. non-unionized libraries, from the same survey



Issues of Representation


- Name of union
